Santé is located in historic downtown Matthews. 165 North Trade Street was originally home to various businesses since the 1880's including a barber shop offering Saturday night baths for gentlemen. In 1996, the building was placed on the National Register of Historic Places.

In March of 2001, executive chef Adam Reed and his wife Veronica Reed took over what was formerly The Hidden Garden Restaurant and re-named it Santé in honor of Adam's French heritage. Adam has extensive experience in fine dining beginning with his apprenticeship at René Pujol's in New York City and including working as sous chef at the famous Russian Tea Room and at Maxim's in New York City.

The nose shows caramel and spices that mingle with red berry fruit. The palate is full and deep with fine tannins and good length.

Big tannins and ripe fruits result in a wine that is dense and structured. The wood aging is apparent, thanks to a smoky character that pushes over the blackcurrant fruit.

Columbia Valley. Opening with orange blossom, jasmine, lemon, apricot, tangerine and cinnamon. A natural crisp acidity balances the slight sweetness, providing a refreshing finish.		
Artisan Sauvignon Blanc	28	8
Sonoma. Soft, fresh lemon aromas give way to a satisfying and refreshing palate of lemon curd, lime, and just a hint of grapefruit.		
Ferrari Carano Fumé Blanc	30	8
Sonoma. A delicious wine with aromas and flavors of yellow peach, pear, quince, Meyer lemon, mango and fruit cocktail. This wine has bright acidity and crisp freshness from the cool, stainless steel tank fermentation, while the subtle oak character from barrel aging adds body, complexity and depth.

Showing buoyant aromas of honeysuckle, citrus blossom, lime zest and earth, this Chardonnay has complexity which is due, in part, to the barrel fermentation and lees aging process.
